

Fall 2017 – Winter 2018 DINING LICENSE AGREEMENT



DINING PLAN: All dining plans begin on August 26, 2017 and end on May 2, 2018.

- A. I understand if I have a meal plan for the Fall 2017 semester, it will begin with breakfast on August 26, 2017 and end with dinner on December 19, 2017.
- B. I understand if I have a meal plan for the Winter 2018 semester, it will begin with breakfast on January 8, 2017 and end with dinner on May 1, 2018.
- C. I understand my meal plan will not work during the University break periods of Thanksgiving Break (all meals on November 22, 2017 – all meals on November 26, 2017), Semester Break (all meals on December 20, 2017 – all meals on January 7, 2018) and Spring Break (after dinner on March 9, 2018 – all meals on March 18, 2018). An exception to the above is the late night meal option that will be available from 8:00pm to 12:00am on Sunday, November 26, 2017, Sunday, January 7, 2018, and Sunday, March 18, 2018. A block meal plan can be purchased when the dining halls are open and not accepting residential meal plans during breaks.

DINING LICENSE AGREEMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. MEAL PLAN WEEK: The number of meals purchased per week can be used anytime during the meal plan week which begins with Breakfast on Monday and ends with Late Night on Sunday. There are 26 meal periods in each week: Sunday-Thursday; Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner and Late Night; Friday and Saturday; Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

2. MEAL SCHEDULE DURING HOLIDAY AND UNIVERSITY CLOSURE:

I understand my meal plan will not work during the University break periods of Thanksgiving Break (all meals on November 22, 2017 – all meals on November 26, 2017), Semester Break (all meals on December 20, 2017 – all meals on January 7, 2018) and Spring Break (after dinner on March 9, 2018 – all meals on March 18, 2018). An exception to the above is the late night meal option that will be available from 8:00pm to 12:00am on Sunday, November 26, 2017, Sunday, January 7, 2018, and Sunday, March 18, 2018. A block meal plan can be purchased when the dining halls are open and not accepting residential meal plans during breaks.

3. WARRIOR DOLLARS: The Unlimited Plans and Weekly Plans come with Warrior Dollars. Warrior Dollars are a flexible declining balance account allotted on a per semester basis. Allotted Warrior Dollars remaining on any meal plan at the end of the Fall Semester roll forward to the Winter Semester. All meal plans and Warrior Dollars expire at the end of Winter Semester. At the discretion of Housing and Residential Life, locations where Warrior Dollars are accepted may change during the year.

4. MEAL PLAN USAGE: Meal plans and Warrior Dollars are encoded on the Wayne State University ID Card, which must be presented to enter a residential dining facility or use Warrior Dollars at other participating campus food vendors. At the discretion of Wayne State Dining Services, dining locations and hours may vary.

5. CHANGE/CANCELLATION POLICY: Requests to alter this contract for medical exceptions or special needs should be directed to: Housing and Residential Life, Wayne State University, 5221 Gullen Mall, SCB 582, Detroit, Michigan 48202.

A. I understand that I do not have the right to cancel my license agreement unless I meet one of the following reasons:

- a. I can cancel for any reason up to June 30, 2017
- b. I can cancel for any reason within 14 calendar days from the day I signed my license agreement. I understand that after I have used any portion of my meal plan, that cancellation period no longer applies.
- c. I can cancel if I graduate or I am no longer an enrolled student at Wayne State University. (Please note that enrollment in online courses or satellite campus courses count as being an enrolled student).
- d. I can cancel if I participate in a student teaching assignment that is further than 40 miles from WSU's Detroit campus.
- e. I can cancel if I participate in an out-of-state or out-of-country internship, co-op, or study abroad program.
- f. I can cancel if my medical documentation proves I developed a medical condition after signing my license agreement that campus dining cannot accommodate and prohibits eating in Towers Café and Gold 'n' Greens. Supporting documentation must be provided using the Dietary Physician Form and must be completed by a licensed medical physician.

B. I understand that if I am approved for cancellation because I am no longer a registered student and I re-enroll at Wayne State University within the same academic year, my license agreement will be reinstated and I will be responsible for any applicable charges.

C. If approved for cancellation, I understand that I will be charged for any meal plan usage, both meal swipes and Warrior Dollars, on my account.

D. If I am not approved for cancellation, I understand that I am liable for the price of the meal plan I selected and the license agreement I signed.

E. I understand that if I am academically dismissed or medically withdrawn from the University, it is my responsibility to request to cancel my license agreement by submitting a license agreement cancellation to the Office of Housing & Residential Life.

F. I understand that in the event that I elect to move off campus housing and/or turn in my keys to the front desk during the term of this license agreement, I remain responsible for all license agreement charges for my meal plan for the 2017-2018 academic year.

G. I understand that all cancellation requests must be submitted to the Office of Housing and Residential Life, Wayne State University, 5221 Gullen Mall, SCB 582, Detroit, Michigan 48202, using the Dining License Agreement Cancellation Request Form.
